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Ignite Innovation

We often struggle trying to define what innovation means. This lack of understanding stifles the re-shaping of our culture to be more innovative. Innovation is not the result of a lone genius coming up with a brilliant idea; rather it is a collaborative process where people of various skills and talents and from many different parts of the organization contribute to the creation and implementation of new ideas. In this presentation we'll explore how to foster an organizational culture that works collaboratively for innovation. We'll discuss how to overcome some of the challenges to innovation and grab the opportunities that a culture of innovation will generate. Organizational Change that Sticks

However, all of this presents an opportunity to do things better. We must ask ourselves some important questions: Do management and staff really understand the change? Are the right strategies in place to manage the change? Do we even know what the problem is that we're trying to fix?

This keynote address will move you beyond the notion of quick fixes and into the realm of solutions that lead to Change Management Strategies. You will increase your understanding of change means and why change initiatives often fail, as well as, how to: develop change strategies, create a vision for your organization and/or department regarding change and translate that vision into a series of effective change management strategies.
